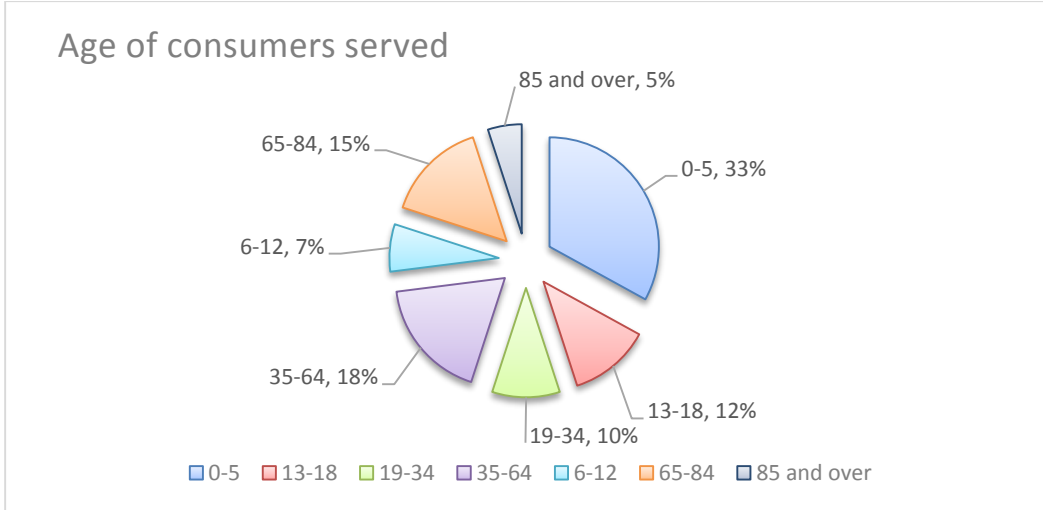
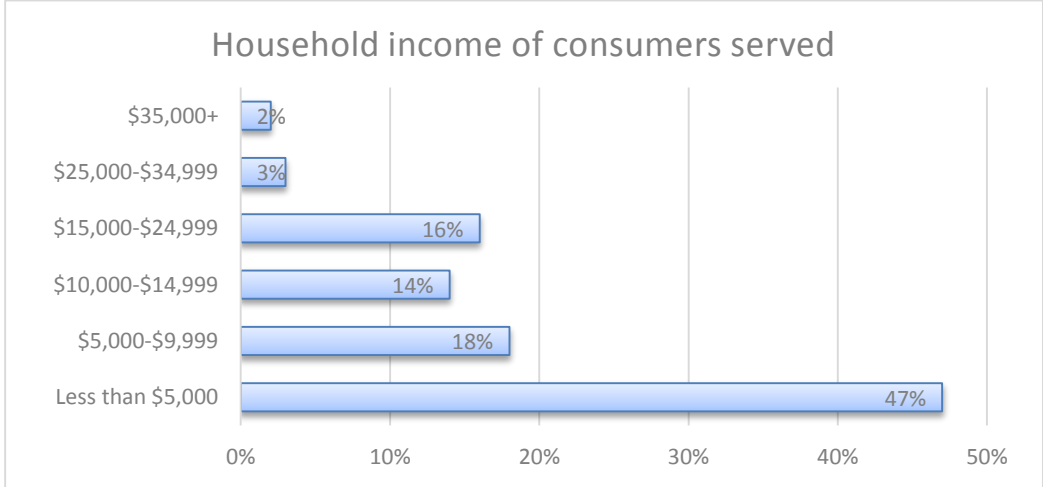
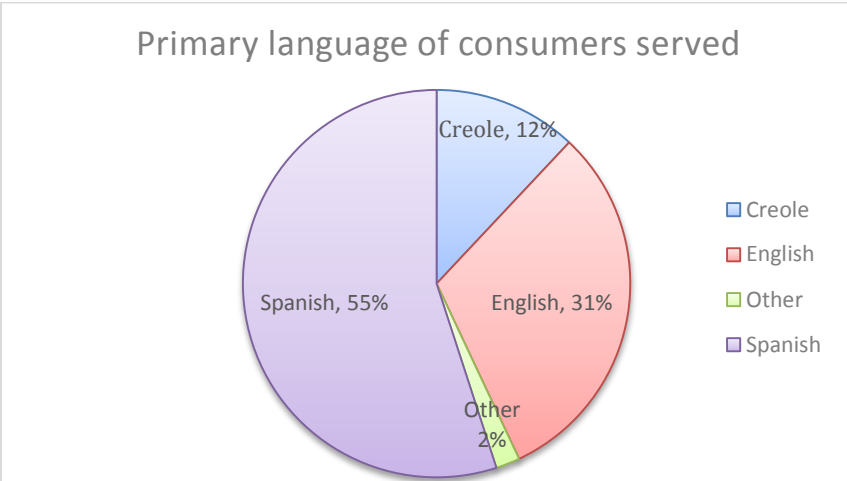
Summary

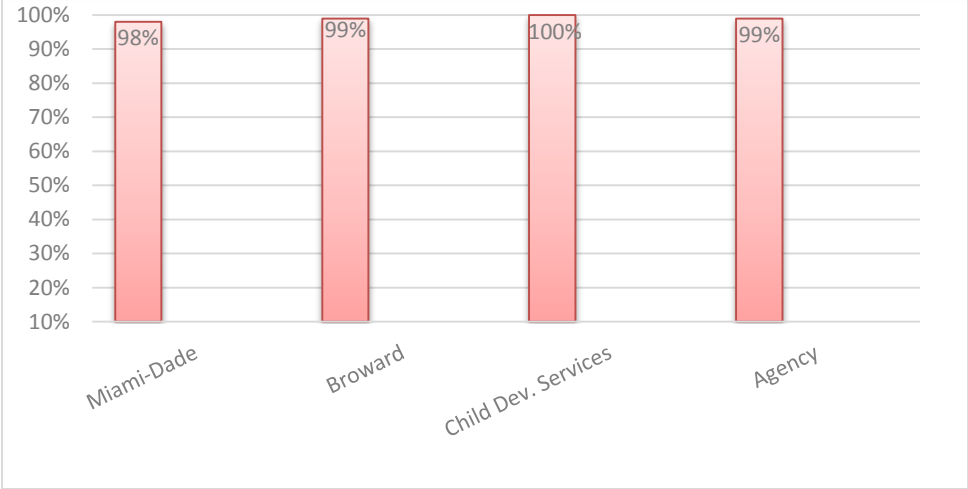


Consumer Demographics Information

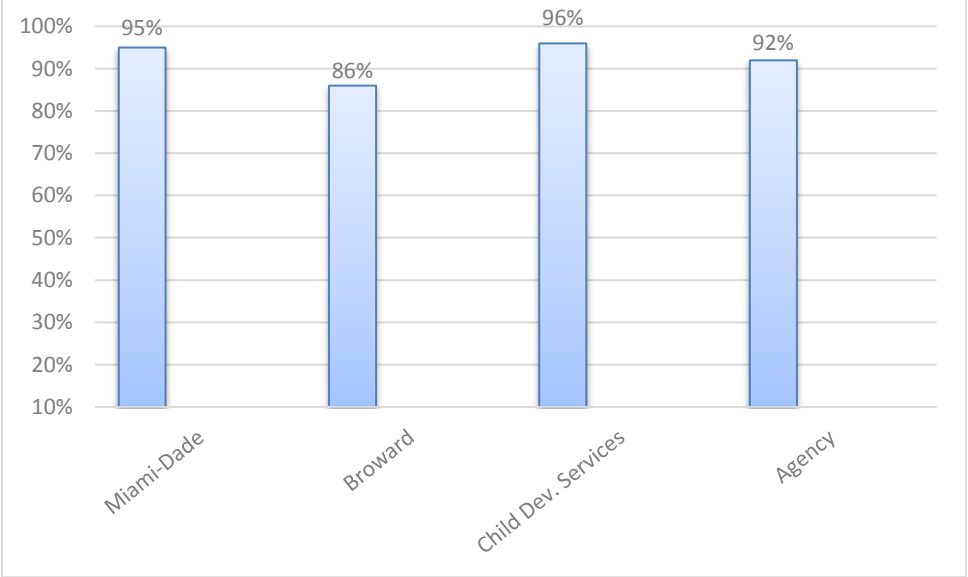


Consumer Satisfaction Survey Results
