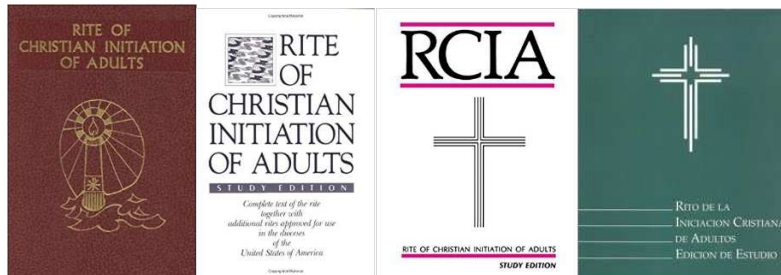

## Archdiocesan Liturgies for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

- **Rite of Election** - Sunday, February 18, 2018 - 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. [n. 6.2, 118-137]
- **Neophyte Mass** – Due to low attendance, there will be NO neophyte Mass this year at the cathedral.
- **Reception of Baptized Christians into Full Communion of the Catholic Church and Confirmation, Eucharist** - Sunday, April 29, 2018 – 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. [n.473-504]

- **Easter Vigil** - Saturday, March 31, 2018 [n. 219-246]

\*Candidates for Confirmation and First Eucharist may also receive the sacraments on a Sunday during the Easter season at the parish if they do not go to the Rite of Reception.

\* “Since children who have reached the use of reason are considered, for the purposes of Christian initiation, to be adults (canon 852:1), their formation should follow the general pattern of the ordinary catechumenate as far as possible, with appropriate adaptations permitted by the ritual. They should receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, together with the older catechumens.” [Appendix III, n. 18]

\* **Seven as the age of reason.** [O]n completion of the seventh year [...] the minor is presumed to have the use of reason. [see Can. 97:1, 2]
