



The first Emmaus Retreat was held in the Archdiocese of Miami at the Dominican Retreat House in 1978. It was developed and conducted by a team of lay women from St. Louis Church and since has spread to parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Miami, other cities, states and even internationally. The retreat is based on the scripture passage found in the Gospel of Luke.

The retreat offers a unique opportunity for personal, spiritual growth simply by discovering a new relationship with God and others. It is a spiritual retreat, to strengthen and renew your relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ, organized by the men from St. Timothy Catholic Church.
