Next weekend, First Sunday of Advent, beginning with our Saturday Vigil Mass at 5:00 p.m., all of our Masses will be celebrated at HolyRosary + St. Richard Catholic Church, located at 7500 SW 152nd Street, Palmetto Bay, FL 33157, our North Campus.

Over the past few weeks, we have seen the results of the hard work of many of the ministers and volunteers of both churches, who have successfully unified important ministries. The Continuing Faith Formation programs for children and adults, Food Pantries, Financial Councils, and our Music and Liturgical Ministries are all working as one now. Our worship space and office will be located on the North campus.

The current building that has housed our church for the past few years and which was built to be a banquet facility, will be converted into a multi-purpose space to provide a much-needed cafeteria for the school and also to be a place where the school children can assemble to share the Eucharist. The space will be available for meetings, school and community gatherings, and hopefully, be a source of revenue for our parish, too. Likewise, the convent building, which served as church office for the past few years, will be returned to the school for school use.
