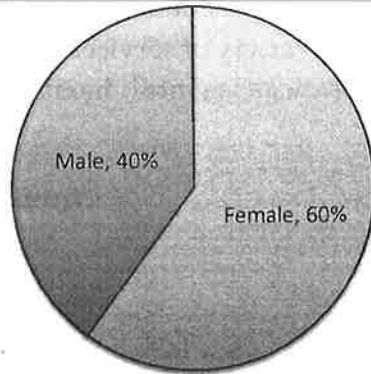

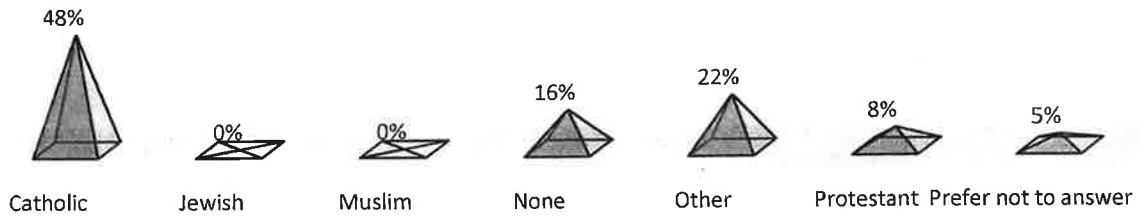

Gender of consumers served

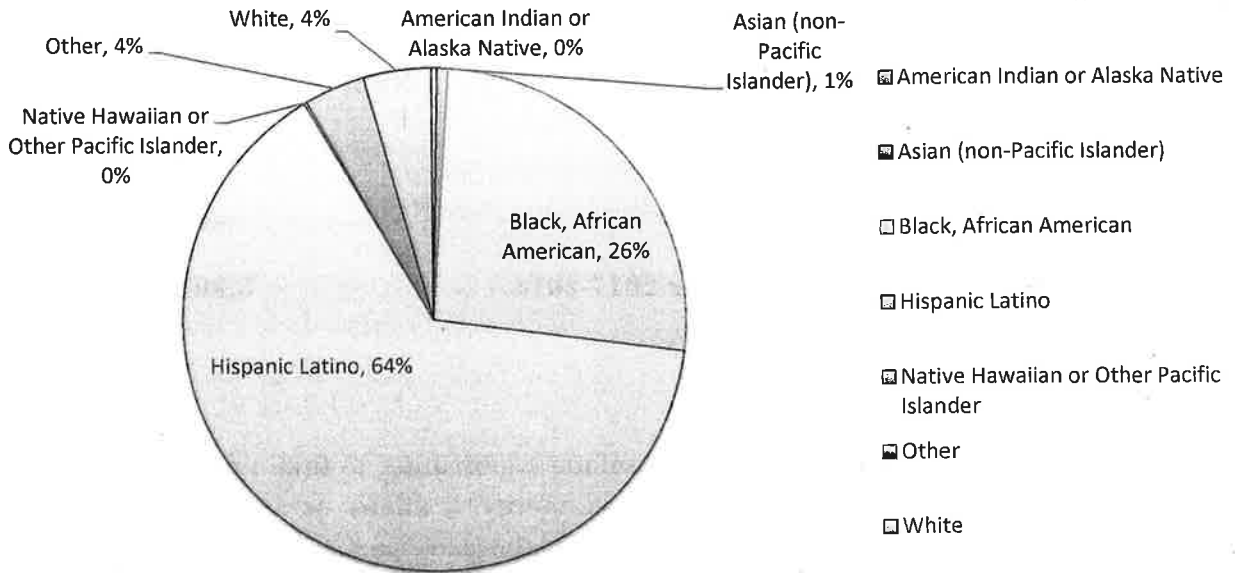

Religion of consumers served



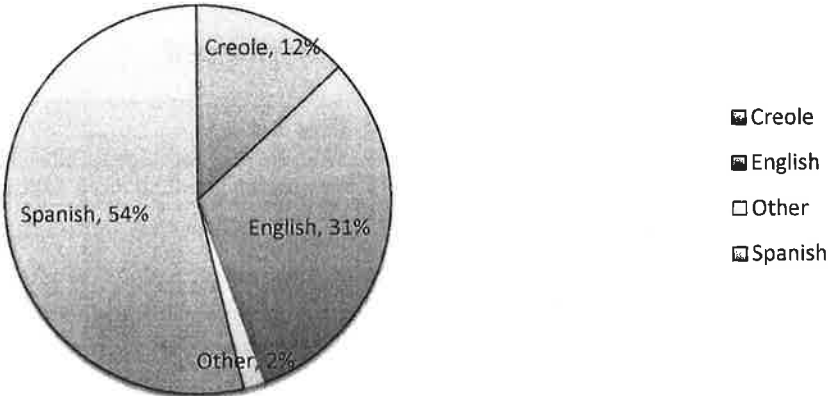
Race/Ethnicity of consumers served



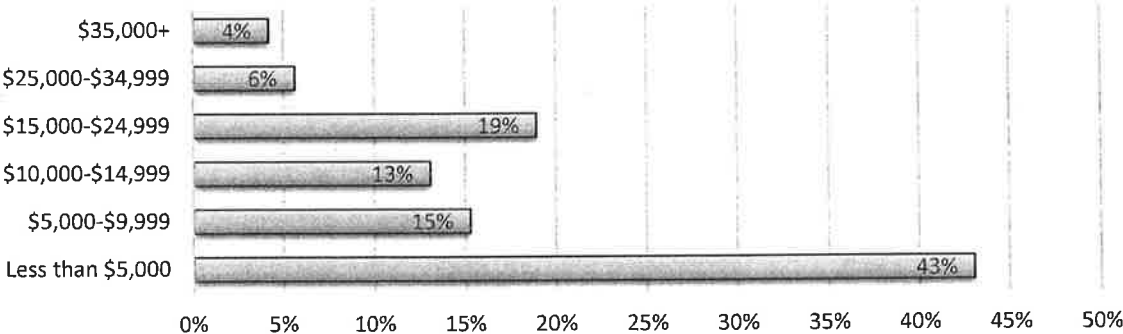

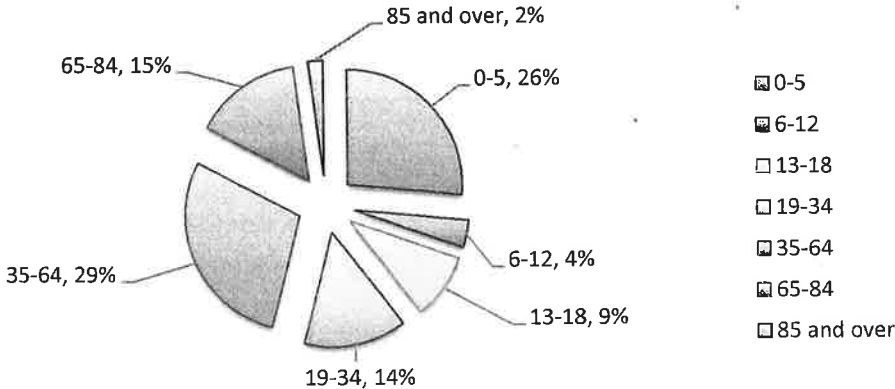
Primary language of consumers served



Household income of consumers served

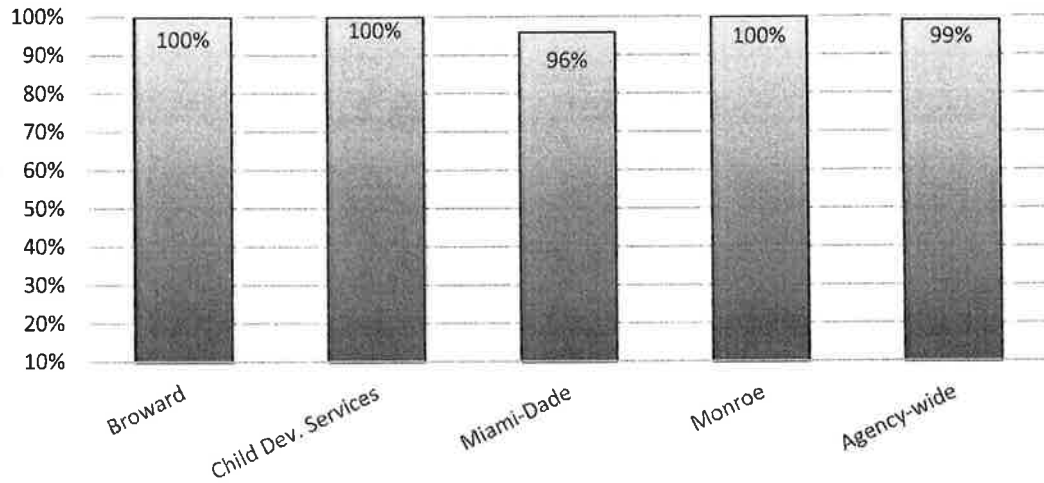


Age of consumers served

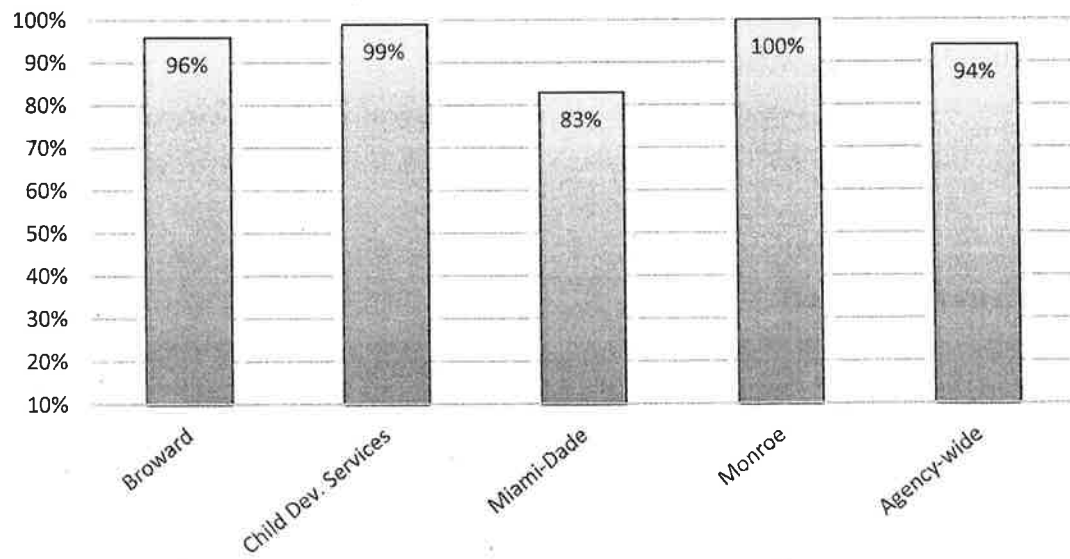


Consumer Satisfaction Survey Results
