Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy:

For the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis is granting indulgences to people who visit the four papal basilicas or a cathedral where they live; to anyone who "performs just one of the traditional works of mercy;" and also to prisoners, those suffering from illness, or elderly people who attend Mass or pray wherever they can.

The Year of Mercy in the Archdiocese of Miami:

The following churches in the Archdiocese will have a designated *Holy Door*. In this way, the Jubilee will be celebrated both in Rome and throughout the Archdiocese of Miami as a visible sign of the Church's universal communion. Holy Doors in the Archdiocese of Miami:

The opening of the Holy Door is scheduled for Dec. 13 at St. Mary Cathedral at 10 a.m. followed by a Mass celebrated by Archbishop Thomas Wenski. The same day all other Holy Doors in the Archdiocese of Miami will open.
