National Vocation Awareness Week - Nov 5-11, 2017

National Vocation Awareness Week (NVAW) is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promoting vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated life through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations. NVAW began in 1976 when the U. S. bishops designated the 28th Sunday of the year for NVAW. In 1997, this celebration was moved to coincide with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which falls on January 13 in 2013. Beginning in 2014, NVAW was moved to the first full week of November. 

Meet our Keynote Speakers!



Dr. Anthony Levatino is a former abortion provider. From selfish motives to true understanding, Dr. Levatino discusses what it was like to perform abortions as part of his OB-GYN practice in upstate New York. Dr. Levatino will share his unique perspective about why a physician who has been trained to give life would take it away. He did as many as 1,200 abortions – some of them after 20 weeks of pregnancy. The story of his

conversion to the pro-life cause has educated and motivated audiences world-wide.

Dr. Levatino will be giving two presentations at the conference; "Recognizing the Humanity of the Unborn Child" and in a closed session for priests and deacons, "Helping Priests Understand the Lies and Deceptions of the Abortion Industry."



Dr. Alveda C. King, niece of Martin Luther King, Jr., is the Pastoral Associate and Director of Civil Rights for the Unborn, and African-American Outreach for Priests for Life. Dr. King is the recipient of the Cardinal John O'Connor Pro-Life Hall of Fame Award and the Civil Rights Award from Congress of Racial Equality and a bestselling author among whose books is, "How Can the

Dream Survive if we Murder the Children?"

In her own words:

"Abortion and racism are evil twins, born of the same lie. Where racism hides its face in public, abortion is accomplishing the goals of which racism only once dreamed. Together, abortionists are destroying humanity at large and the black community in particular."

"When we said we would no longer sit on the back of the bus, a place was being reserved for us down at the abortion clinic."

Dr. King will be giving two presentations at the conference; "Civil Rights for the Unborn" and in a closed session for priests and deacons, "Importance of the Priest's Role in Defending the Least Among Us."


