Invite a friend to Welcome Weekend

As part of its 60th anniversary celebration, the Archdiocese of Miami will host a Welcome Weekend at all parishes **Dec. 8 and 9**. The goal is to encourage parishioners to personally invite people they know to "come and see" the Catholic Church for themselves. These guests may be family members, friends, neighbors or those the world considers "the least, the last and the lost." They may be Catholics, drifted-away Catholics, members of another church or the rapidly increasing "nones."

It's a challenge Archbishop Thomas Wenski wrote about in the Strategic Pastoral Plan that resulted from the recent archdiocesan synod: "Many told me that the reason why it took them so long to become Catholic or return to the faith was that no one had asked them. ... I am inviting every Catholic in South Florida to invite one other person to this or another event at your parish."

Retirement Fund for Religious

The annual Retirement Fund for Religious collection will take place Dec. 8-9 in the Archdiocese of Miami. The collection is coordinated by the National Religious Retirement Office (NRRO) in Washington, and benefits 31,000 elderly Catholic sisters, brothers and religious order priests. The 2017 collection raised just over \$28 million nationwide and the NRRO disbursed \$25 million to benefit 360 religious communities for the direct care of elderly members. Almost 94% of donations aid senior religious and their communities, with the remaining funds used for administration and promotion of the national appeal.
