Requiescat in pace:

† **Sister John Norton**, longtime principal of St. Thomas Aquinas High School in Fort Lauderdale, died Feb. 7 at the age of 98, after 74 years in religious life.

† **Father Restituto Perez, O.P.,** 89, died Feb. 13. He was born in Spain on May 29, 1933, and was ordained priest on June 4, 1960, for the Dominican Order. He spent his entire time in South Florida serving at St. Dominic Parish in Miami: first as pastor (1983-1986), then as parochial vicar (1986-1989) and again until his retirement (1991-2000). He was still in residence with the Dominican community at St. Dominic.

St. Patrick's Day Dispensation

March 17th is observed by many as St. Patrick's Day. This year, March 17 falls on a Friday of Lent, a day of fasting and abstinence. Many have asked for a dispensation from the obligation for fasting and abstinence in order to celebrate this Saint who is the Patron Saint of Ireland and Nigeria. As Archbishop of Miami, I grant the dispensation to anyone who wishes to observe the Saint's Day with a meal that includes meat but, at the same time, I encourage those who will avail themselves of this dispensation to consider substituting on that day the Lent Friday Fast and abstinence with another suitable penance, work of charity, or prayer.

Pontifical Good Friday Collection

Pastors: Please announce the following from the pulpit and in your bulletins:

Pope Francis has asked our archdiocese to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land. Your support is essential to help the Church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools and religious education. It also helps to preserve the sacred shrines of Christianity, including in Jerusalem, Bethlehem and Nazareth. The pandemic hit Christians in the Holy Land particularly hard. In these times of crisis, the Pontifical Good Friday Collection is necessary to meet the basic needs of the children of God still living in this land and to maintain a Christian presence where Christ was born. Priest retreats:

May 15 – 19, 2023, Preacher: Bishop Felipe Estevez Theme: Meditations on the Gospel of St John

A Church Father called the fourth Gospel "the spiritual Gospel". Participants will be enriched by a deeper gaze of some of the stories unique to this Gospel drawing pastoral implications.

Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola

The Spiritual Exercises of Saint Ignatius of Loyola will be offered at the Joseph and Mary Retreat House in Mundelein, IL from July 2 to August 4, 2023.

A team of trained spiritual directors, under the leadership of Fr. John Horn, SJ and Dr. Carol Razza, offer the 30-day, 8-day, 5-day, and 3-day forms of the Spiritual Exercises. The program is co-sponsored by Jesus Youth and Amoris Christi.

During the retreat, participants experience God's invitations to be loved, reconciled and called to live in companionship with Jesus' Spirit. The Spiritual Exercises are a type of map for the human heart to follow in prayerful meditation and contemplation.

Retreats, Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola, continued:

The cost for the 30-day retreat is \$3,400 and includes all materials and stipend for spiritual direction. The 3, 5 and 8 day retreats cost \$110 per day. Preference for admission to the 30-day retreat is given to bishops, seminary formators, vocation directors, priests, deacons and their wives, religious and lay leaders involved in spiritual formation and evangelization.

Prerequisites include having made two week-long silent directed retreats or the equivalent. Silent conference retreats without daily individual spiritual direction or quiet time spent in a monastic setting for days of personal retreat do not fulfill the prerequisites. Exceptions to these prerequisites can be discussed if there seems to be an equivalent spiritual preparation through intensive spiritual formation programs and/or life experience. A telephone interview is required. During this interview daily habits of prayer and the regularity of spiritual direction are discussed as well as one's personal experience of God's love.

The Archdiocese of Miami fully supports the message of the Blessed Virgin Mary from Fatima and strongly promotes devotion to the Holy Rosary.

However, the Archdiocese of Miami does not endorse nor allows the group called America Needs Fatima to solicit within the Archdiocese of Miami. This decision was made based on their apparently very aggressive fundraising and marketing strategies. Moreover, this group never requested the Archbishop's permission to exercise this "prayer ministry" within the Archdiocese of Miami. Finally, there are many complaints against the group posted online.

America Needs Fatima Announcement (continued):

We encourage the parishioners to follow the message of Fatima and to pray the Rosary daily. If so desired, please consider other Marian organizations like the Legion of Mary (<u>https://www.legionofmary.ie</u>), the Blue Army (<u>https://www.bluearmy.com</u>), or others approved by the Archdiocese.

La Arquidiócesis de Miami apoya plenamente el mensaje de la Santísima Virgen María de Fátima y promueve firmemente la devoción al Santo Rosario.

Sin embargo, la Arquidiócesis de Miami no respalda ni permite que el grupo llamado America Needs Fatima solicite dentro de la Arquidiócesis de Miami. Esta decisión se basa en sus estrategias de recaudación de fondos y de marketing, aparentemente muy agresivas. Además, este grupo nunca solicitó el permiso del Arzobispo para ejercer este "ministerio de oración" dentro de la Arquidiócesis de Miami. Por último, hay muchas quejas contra el grupo publicadas en Internet.

Animamos a los feligreses a seguir el mensaje de Fátima y a rezar el Rosario diariamente. Si lo desean, por favor consideren otras organizaciones marianas como la Legión de María (<u>https://www.legionofmary.ie</u>), el Blue Army (<u>https://www.bluearmy.com</u>), u otras aprobadas por la Arquidiócesis.

Safe Environment policy update

All those seeking employment or volunteer opportunities can complete Virtus training online which must be completed prior to employment/volunteer/vendor positions begin.

Online training can be accessed 24/7. Both fingerprinting and the initial Virtus training session must be completed (and for fingerprinting the results must be received) prior to serving as an employee, vendor, or volunteer. New hires may take the online training during their first day as part of their orientation. Any other scenario requires the training to be completed prior to working or volunteering.

You can verify participants' status through your location's Virtus User Reports (accessible by your Local Coordinator) or by having the participant turn in their Training Report.
