David G. Monaco, C.P.

is a Passionist priest and Scripture scholar. He is Professor of Sacred Scripture at St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers, New York, now in his fifth year. Prior to that, he was Professor of Sacred Scripture at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio for seven years. He holds an S.S.L. from the Pontifical Biblical Institute in Rome, Italy and a Ph.D. in Biblical Studies from the University of Chicago. He has authored a book, a number of different articles, and two biblical commentaries, "Haggai"



in The Paulist Biblical Commentary and "Ezra-Nehemiah" in The Jerome Biblical Commentary for the Twenty-First Century, and is presently working on a second book.

Father Monaco will share valuable knowledge about how the prophets preached and proclaimed in their own times, and how they were later preached and proclaimed particularly in the New Testament and among the earliest Christians.
